3) All sections of the application form must be completed and submitted.

4) Tuition payments must be paid in full prior to enrolling onto any of the Pre-sessional Programmes.

5) Students who are sponsored must provide an official letter from their sponsors as evidence during the first week. Failure to meet the conditions of the course and/or the sponsorship will result in students being liable for the cost of the course themselves.

6) Prior to beginning study students will be required to complete the online enrolment process agreeing to UCLan's full terms and conditions.

UCLan are obliged to inform the UK Home Office about any students who have a PBS visa and who fail to arrive for the start of course.

Please note that UCLAN is obliged to inform the UK Home Office if students have poor attendance, withdraw, defer or suspend their studies.

10) Students who need to sit re assessment must be available on the given date. This date cannot be negotiated.

11) On completion of the course the student's exam marks and attendance will be sent to the required university schools (for progressing students) and the International Office.

12) Courses will run subject to student numbers. It is important, therefore, that applicants supply a current email address with their application.
